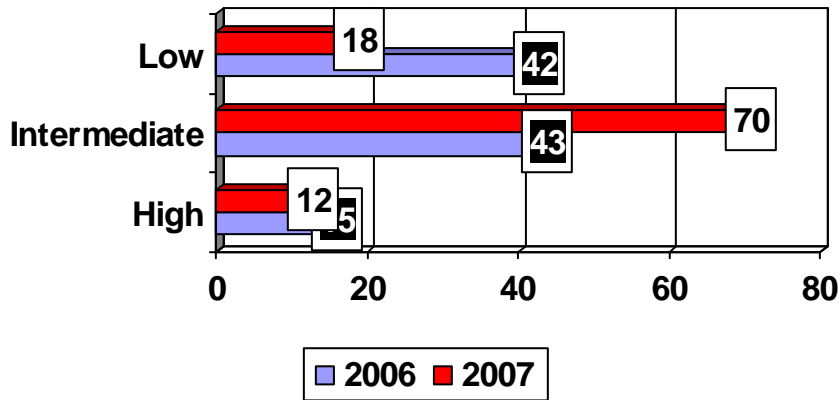


Annual Improvement Goal for Reading 2006-2007

Grade Males**

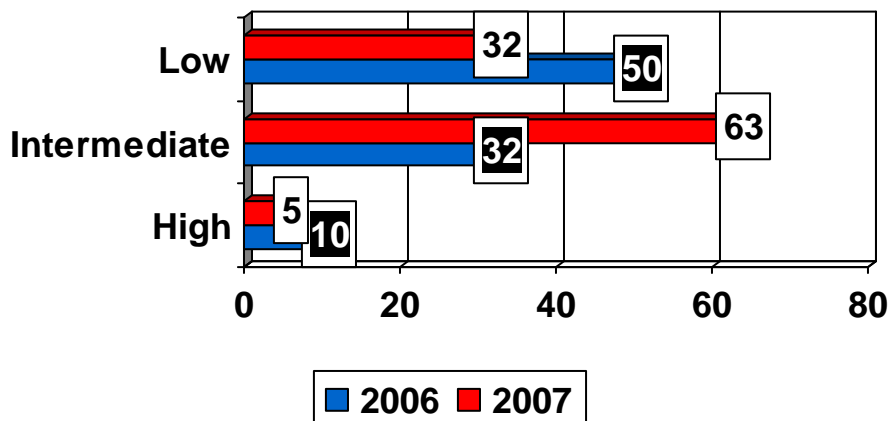


Annual Improvement Goal for Mathematics 2006-2007
