Post Secondary Educational Opportunity Student/Parent Agreement

New this term, we will have a MANDATORY student/parent meeting for those students enrolling in college level courses. This meeting is set for **Tuesday, November 18, 2008** at 6:30 p.m. in the library. **You must make this meeting in order to be enrolled in to the college course of your desire for the spring term.**

As a **high school student** in the state of Iowa enrolling in a post-secondary institution under the Post-Secondary Enrollment Options Act, I understand that I have certain obligations in connection with this enrollment.

- If I do not complete the course, I am responsible for paying the full tuition back to my school district (\$250).
 - If I withdraw from the course, I am still responsible for paying the full tuition back to my school district (\$250).
 - If I receive a failing grade (F) for the course, I am still responsible for paying the full tuition back to my school district (\$250).
- I must attend all classes, or do all assigned work unless otherwise arranged with the instructor and Mrs. Swenson.
- I understand that if I need help, or do not understand something pertaining to the class OR the ILOC computer program that I must ask for help of the instructor or Mrs. Swenson immediately in order to avoid poor grades or deadline violations.
- I understand that the time set aside at Farragut High School for me to do the work in my online class is designated to that work, not other courses I am enrolled in.
- I understand that I must secure a test proctor (if necessary) at least one week before the testing deadline, it is my responsibility to make those arrangements.

As a **parent/guardian** of a high school student in the state of Iowa enrolling in a post-secondary institution under the Post-Secondary Enrollment Options Act, I understand that I have certain obligations in connection with this enrollment.

- If my son/daughter does not complete the course, we are responsible for paying the full tuition back to my school district (\$250).
 - If my son/daughter withdraws from the course, we are still responsible for paying the full tuition back to my school district (\$250).
 - If my son/daughter receives a failing grade (F) for the course, we are still responsible for paying the full tuition back to my school district (\$250).
